- Goalie training

- Kari Gonzales: goalie trainer level I/II certified.
- Pricing structure given to Tino (\$15/kid per session).
- 1 hour for 1-2 kids, 1.5 hours for 4 or more kids.
- 4 kids is ideal practice size.
- U10-12 together, U13-14 together, U16-U19
- Good to try to keep ball size in mind when grouping age groups (U12 #4, U13 #5)
- Monday – Thursday evenings are best. Unavailable 2-4 MWF or 4-6 UH Fridays are difficult
- Any location that is open. A set up goal is ideal, but not necessary.
- We will pool everyone together to figure out numbers and groupings and get back to Kari in 1-2 weeks.

- Club costs

- Roster size. For U16 through U19 the roster can be up to 22, but only 18 game cards can be given to referee at the start of a game.
- Practice/Scrimmage/etc.
 - CYSA and US Club are different clubs with different insurance policies.
 - If you play a team from another Club on your own, you can be personally liable for any health costs and lawsuits.
 - The only time you can play a team from a different Club is at a tournament.
 - Tournaments are different because the tournament directors figure out the insurance (often offer a one day insurance)
- Red card preparation. (Not all of this topic was discussed at this meeting.)
 - In your team binder, keep the following
 - An envelope addressed to the PAD chair with your address as the return address.
 - The “DISTRICT VI METRO LEAGUE PENALTY AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES”
 - “REFEREE’S SEND OFF REPORT”

 - Keep those two documents in the envelope and mark the envelope red.
 - If a red card is given to someone on your team, respectfully give the referee the envelope explaining that you are trying to avoid confusion so you are giving them the rules, the form, and the pre-addressed envelope.
